

CALIFORNIA CODES
HEALTH AND **SAFETY CODE**
SECTION **17960-17967**

17960. The building department of every city or county **shall** enforce within its jurisdiction **all the provisions published in the State Building Standards Code**, the provisions of this part, and the other rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to the provisions of this part pertaining to the erection, construction, reconstruction, movement, enlargement, conversion, alteration, repair, removal, demolition, or arrangement of apartment houses, hotels, or dwellings.

The County of Santa Cruz through the Board of Supervisors, County Administrator, County Counsel, Planning Department and Code Enforcement have not posted on the county website the California Building Standards Codes (International and Uniform Building Codes) for citizens to use. They do not certify and train themselves as the county officials and do not certify and train staff to use these codes. They deny citizens due process and relief by rigging local ordinances and ignoring State building codes at the administrative hearings. An independent appeals board is legally required and the county is legally required to institute the use of the California Building Standards Codes: both do not exist and have been concealed for 33 years.
