Chapter 2.38 BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, COMMITTEES AND
DEPARTMENT ADVISORY GROUPS GENERALLY

2.38.210 Filling scheduled vacancies.

On or before December 31st of each year, the clerk of the board of supervisors shall prepare an appointment list of all regular and ongoing commissions and committees, which shall contain the following information:

- A. A list of all appointive terms which will expire during the next calendar year, with the name of the incumbent appointee, the date of appointment, the date the term expires, and the necessary qualifications for the position.
- B. A list of all commissions and committees whose members serve at the pleasure of the board of supervisors and the necessary qualifications for each position. (Ord. 4573 § 1 (part), 1999: prior code § 3.01.080(j)(3); Ord. 2078, 12/17/74; Ord. 2390, 2/8/77; Ord. 3044, 2/24/81; Ord. 3285, 8/3/82)

Comment:

If this list was maintained and if it was not maintained, it reveals that the Board of Supervisors should have made sure that lawful functioning appeal boards exist/ed. In addition, the Civil Service Commission along with the County Administrator, Personnel Dept. Head and the Board of Supervisors would have discerned the occupation of more than one commission seat held by nepotic first-degree relations.
